Effective July 1, branch offices of the South Carolina DMV will no longer collect taxes on boats and boat motors. This is due to the rollout of Project Phoenix.

Walk in traffic- Walk in traffic may pay casual excise tax in one of the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources (SCDNR) offices in Charleston or Columbia.

However, the DMV offices will continue to follow the same procedures for watercraft licenses as always. We will provide the **SCDNR Boating Exam** and if the applicant passes the written knowledge test (they may miss 6 answers out of 30 questions) the **South Carolina Boater's Certificate** should be issued.
