It's Time to Winterize

It's time again to prepare your boat for the long winter slumber. Each spring we see many boats that need major repairs. With preventive maintenance during winterization, you reduce the risk of major repair bills in the spring.

To properly winterize a boat and motor, here are some of the items Gunnells Marine performs:

- Visually check the boat and motor
- Stabilize fuel
- Start engine
- Check shift and throttle cable
- Check steering cable
- Fog engine
- Run fuel out of carburetors if two stroke engines
- Drain block & manifolds
- Check trim tab
- Remove and replace gear lube
- Check fluid levels
- Grease fittings
- Check prop

Gunnells Marine also recommends changing the oil in an inboard, four stroke and I/O boat motors yearly.

We also strongly recommend changing the water impeller every two years regardless of how many hours the motor has run.

Bring your boat in today and you will be ready for plenty of fun next spring.
